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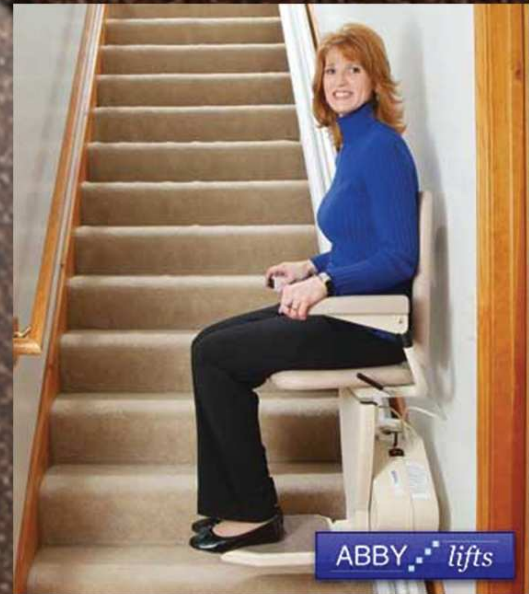
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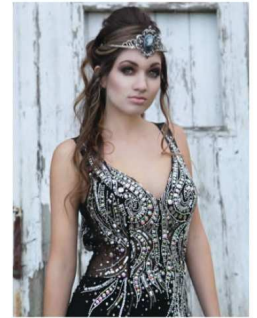

Built in 1908, the building was occupied by the New Hope Borough Municipal Offices and Police State from 1973 to 1998. The Eagle Fire Co. building is the oldest standing firehouse in Bucks County and amongst the oldest in Pennsylvania.

The fire house was renovated in 2012 and has become home to The Café at The Four Crows. The original design, brickwork, and interior woodwork has been retained, with the keystone of the New Hope Eagle Fire Co. proudly displayed at the top of the building.

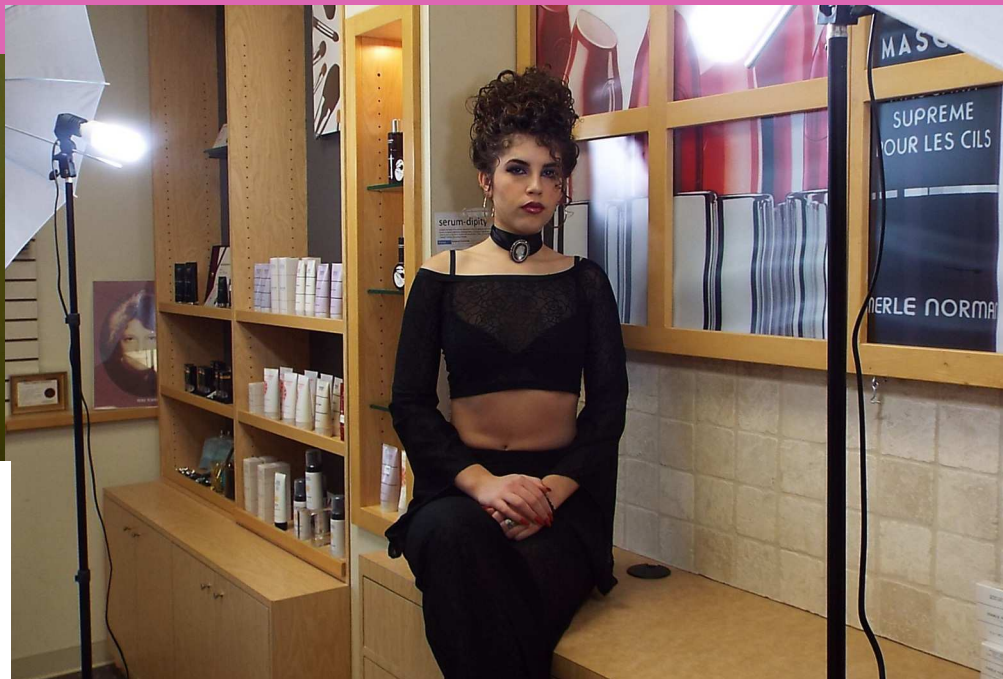

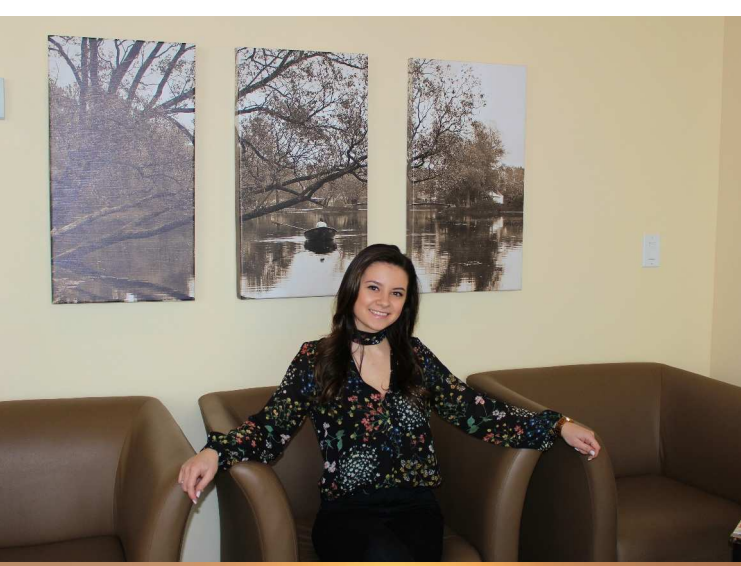

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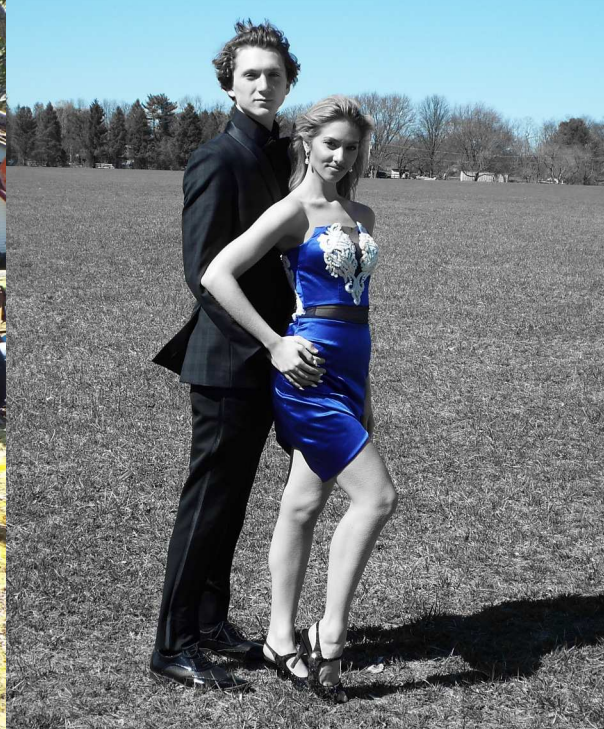

CELEBRITY MAKEUP ARTIST AMANDA TERRY

You may remember her from American Beauty Star on Lifetime channel, hosted by Supermodel Adriana Lima and Celebrity Makeup Artist Sir John, who's done makeup for well-known celebrities such as Beyonce and many others worldwide. And if you haven't watched the show, chances are you've seen her work.

We caught up with Amanda Terry, aka Makeup Mandi, on Huntington Beach to talk about her start, the show, and her next project. "When I was young, I would do my mom's hair and makeup. And when all my cousins would come over, I'd do an entire makeover." About 18 years ago, she took a drama class and was introduced to special effects makeup. Her reaction to that? "It was awesome! Special effects became my passion." Having grown up in Yucaipa, CA, she didn't hear much about makeup artists, "I didn't know if I can make a career out of it, but I researched makeup schools to become certified." From there her career skyrocketed -she's recently done makeup for Harrison Ford for his training video with the LAFD; LOL network with Kevin Hart; Actress Joanna Cassidy for last year's Blade Runner premier; Comedian/Actress Nicole Arbour; Fitness superstar Lauren Abraham; Michelle Williams; Dancing With The Stars; LA Fashion Week; Red Carpets; Hustler; horror films; music videos; and the list goes on!

Her favorite makeup artist that she looks up to is Patrick Ta. "Our style is very similar! I like to enhance and emphasize my client's natural beauty. I don't pile tons of makeup on them nor exaggerate their look." It was around December 2016 when she applied to American Beauty Star. Out of thousands around the world, they chose 6 makeup artists and 6 hairstylists. And Mandi was one of them. "I had lots of fun and made many friends, but I didn't like how the show portrayed me in a bad light. Editing can be tricky. I wear my heart on my sleeve. I'm not a private person, but I was all about letting my work show my worth. I didn't want the show to be about how I overcame my past. It was a hair and makeup competition, and that's what I was there for. I wanted my head in the game." On her final episode, she wanted her teammate to be in the spotlight. "We were together in all 3 competitions. Without her, the look I created wouldn't be complete. I wanted the world to see her talent. I sabotaged myself by not showing more of myself in the challenge." Despite being cut on the 3rd episode, she came out being sponsored by some of the show sponsors.

After this interview, she'll be on her way to Malibu to do makeup for a music video. And for this year's Diversity in Beauty summit on May 20 headed by Sir John, she'll be on the panel talking about the future of beauty. "It's a summit about what's going on in the beauty world. I'm so excited about it! I really enjoy making people happy when they see themselves as beautiful. I see hairstylists and makeup artists as therapists. We build a personal relationship with our clients and contribute to their wellbeing. It warms my heart seeing them happy. If they look good, they feel good about themselves and have more confidence."

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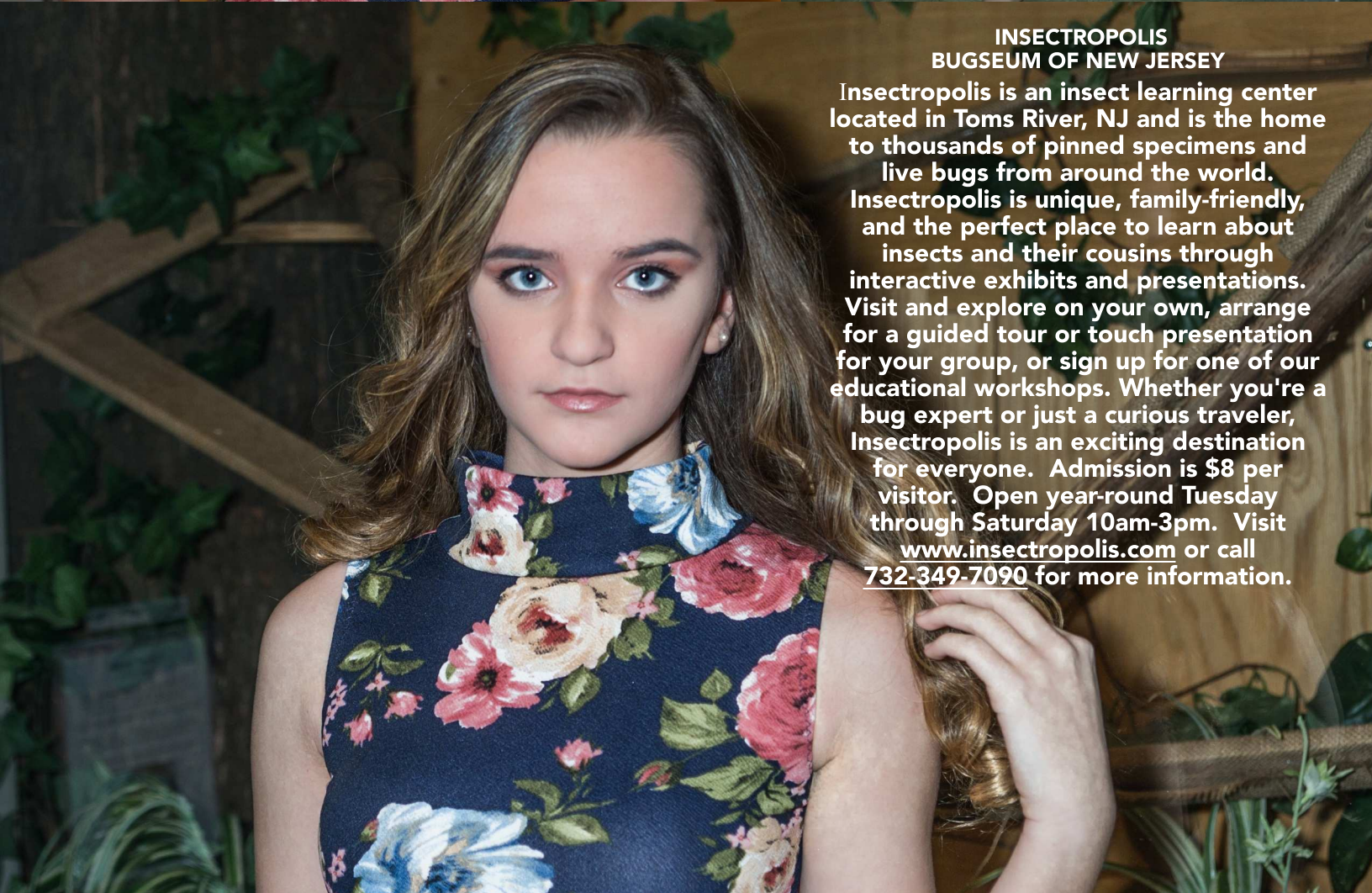

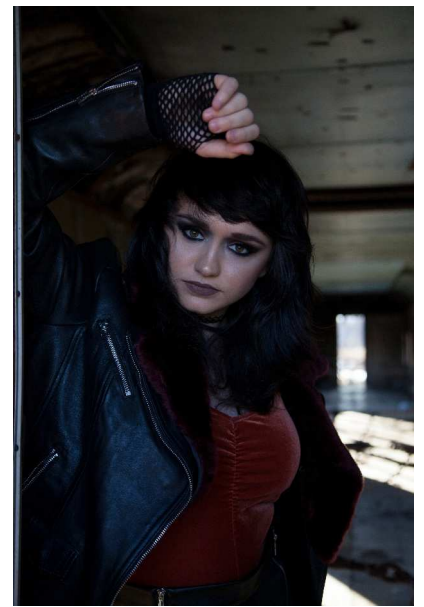




Musician of the Month

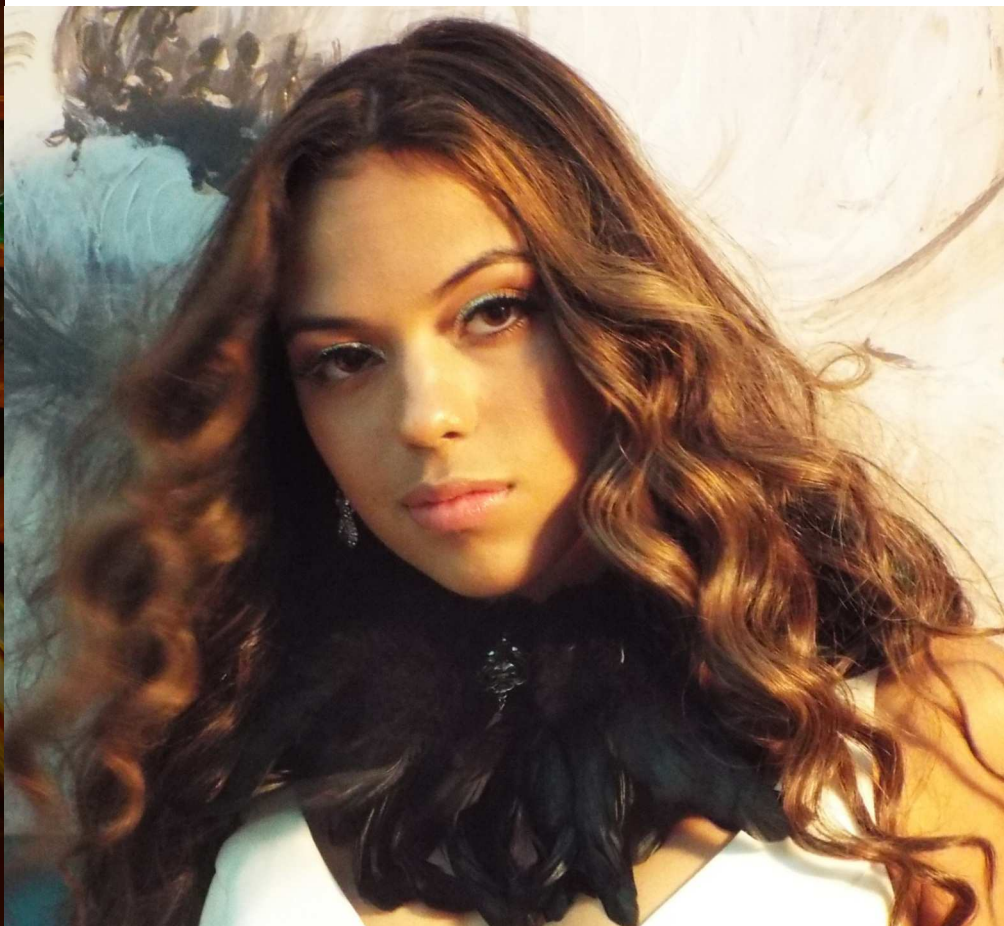
Haunting Beauty of the Month

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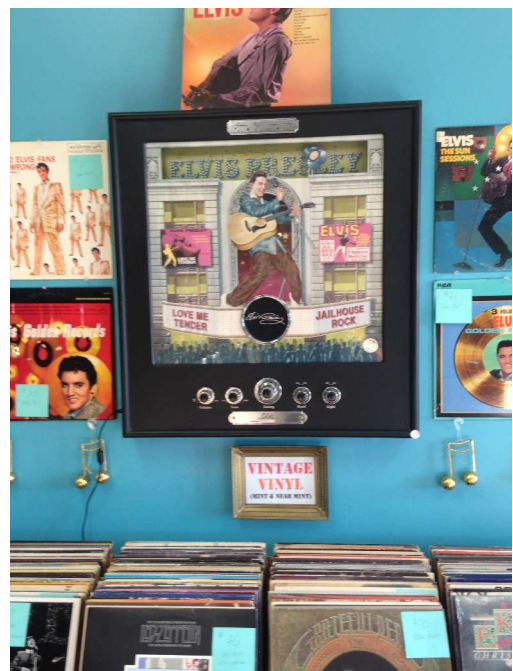
