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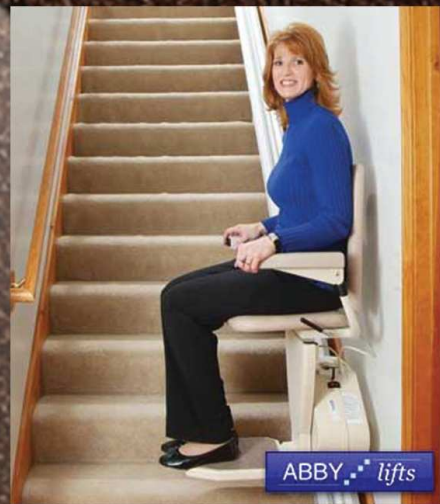

The Haunting Red Mill Museum

Built in 1810 by Ralph Hunt to process wool, the Red Mill is one of the most photographed and haunted places in the country. During its 200 year history, the Red Mill changed hands several times. In 1928, it finally shut down and was restored into the museum it's known as today. What makes it interesting is what happened during those years that led to today's hauntings.

Paul Muir, Museum Director, and Mayor of Bethlehem Township, NJ, explains: "As far as we know, a worker named Frank fell in the 2-story hopper on the 4th floor. Its V-shape made it impossible to get back out. Also on the 4th floor, some workers hung their coworker they were mad at, staging it as a suicide. And there's the daughter of a tenant worker that was playing on the grounds where she died. Supposedly she still haunts the grounds."

The most interaction they have is with Ralph. "After a tour, a mother sent us a complaint about a very gruff worker dressed in period clothes in the restroom. 'What are you doing here? You shouldn't be here!' She asked him his name, and he said Ralph." The museum replied to her apologetically that they didn't have a male re-enactor during her tour.

Raven, one of the staff members, states there are occasional strange interactions with visitors, "As visitors leave, they praise how good and informative a woman wearing a long flowing white dress was demonstrating the spinning wheels. But we didn't have re-enactors that day, and we never have anyone demonstrate them!" She's been spotted in photos taken of the mill at night as a white silhouette in the window.

The more playful one is Frank. "He is known to favor woman, pinching their butts, and pulling their hair -this happened to me several times. I've had experiences with spirits that looks so real!" Marie, the museum's Assistant Director, describes Frank as the prankster. "And Ralph, sometimes referred to as the "overseer", thinks of himself as the boss and is our most confrontational ghost. He likes to make sure everyone is doing their job."

The Genius of Michelangelo Explored in Landmark Exhibition at The Met

Michelangelo: Divine Draftsman and Designer, on view at The Metropolitan Museum of Art from November 13, 2017, through February 12, 2018, will present a stunning range and number of works by the artist: 133 of his drawings, 3 of his marble sculptures, his earliest painting, and his wood architectural model for a chapel vault. A substantial body of complementary works by his teachers, associates, pupils, and artists who were influenced by him or who worked in collaboration with him will also be displayed for comparison and context. A towering genius in the history of Western art, Michelangelo was celebrated during his long life for the excellence of his disegno, the power of drawing and invention that provided the foundation for all of the arts. For his mastery of drawing, design, sculpture, painting, and architecture, he was called *Il divino* ("the divine one") by his contemporaries. His powerful imagery and dazzling technical virtuosity transported viewers and imbued all of his works with a staggering force that continues to enthrall us today.

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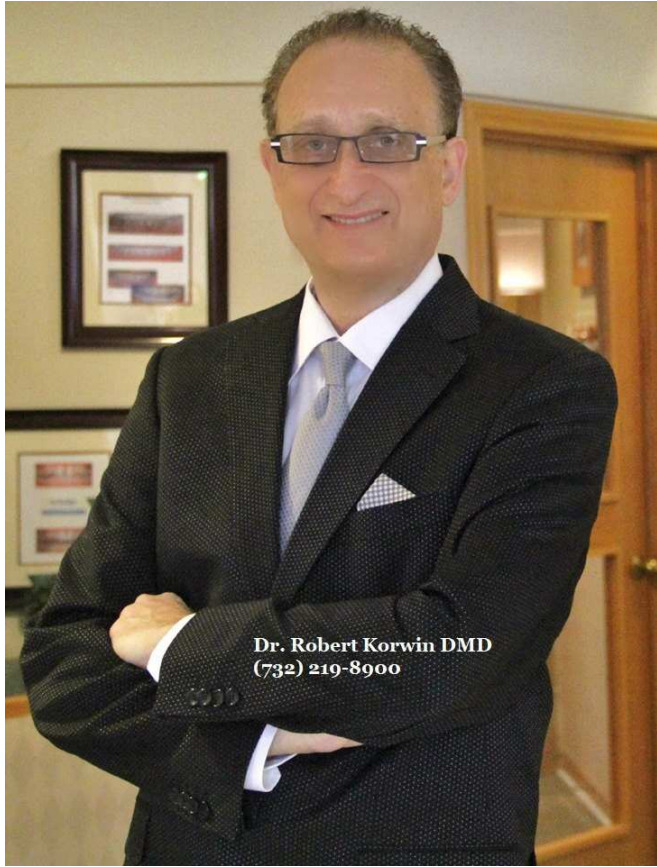
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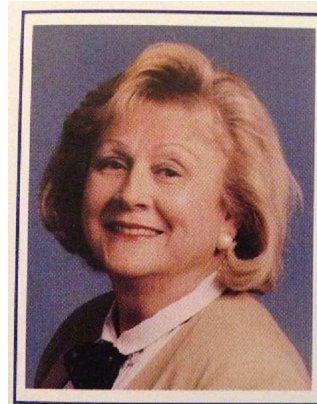

be available for artistic presentations, meetings, independently produced solo exhibits & group shows, book signings, art classes, etc.

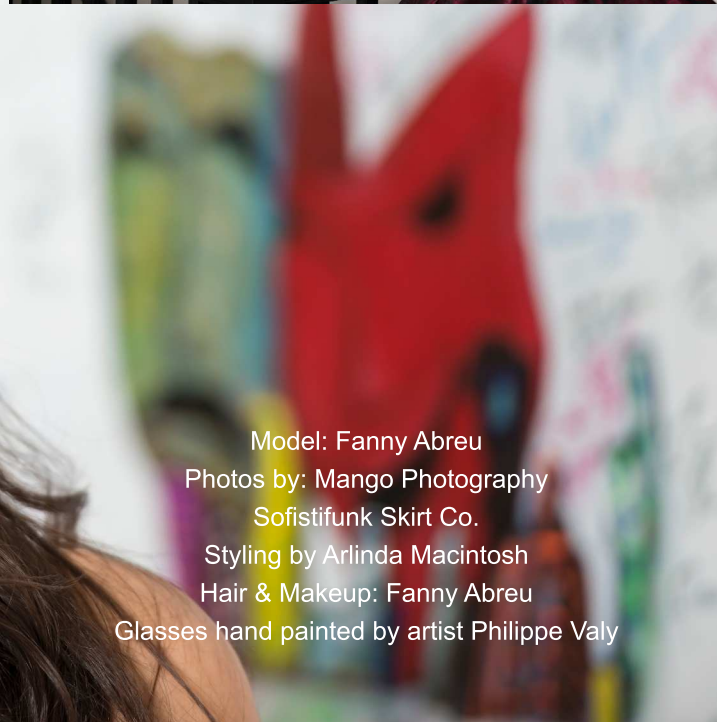

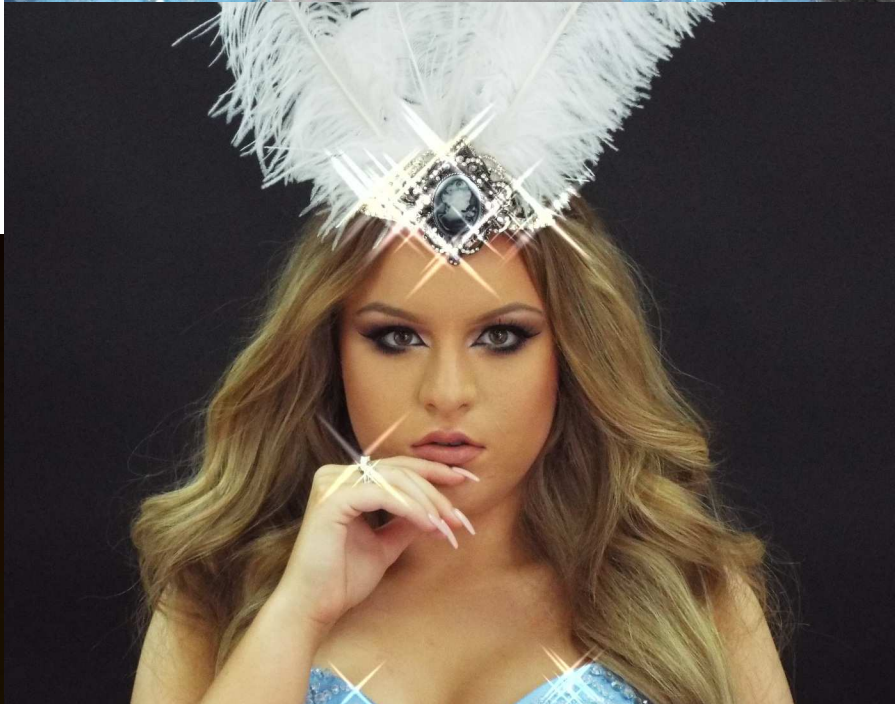


Pageant Queen Alexis Buccellato

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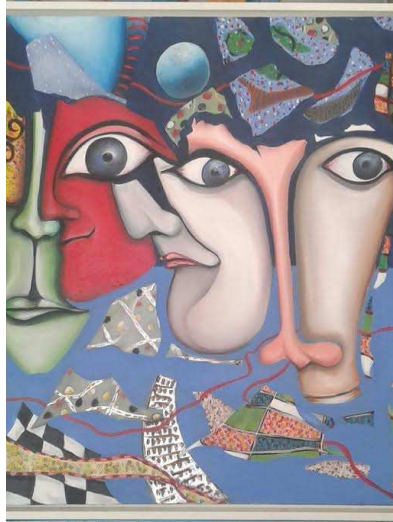

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Our Little Town of Old Bridge, NJ

Thomas-Warne Museum

In 1692 Thomas purchased 1000 acres, on this lot a one room school was erected, and dedicated to the education of the area now known as Thomas Warne Museum.

In October of 1964 a group of pioneering residents of Madison (now Old Bridge) Township got together and with a vision and their own collections of artifacts, research and memories created the Madison-Old Bridge Twp. Historical Society and Thomas Warne Museum. Monday through Friday, by appointment. Open Saturday/Sunday 12pm-4pm.



The History Of The Old Bridge

In the late 1800s into the early 1900s the area now known as Old Bridge consisted mainly of luscious farms and cozy cottages. It became necessary to build bridges so that farmers could cross over the South River for trade. One of the first bridges built was located at the intersection of Old Matawan Road and the South River. This wooden bridge crossed over the river into East Brunswick giving the farmers a greater opportunity to sell their goods. According to Richard Pucciarelli, Historian and staff member at the Thomas Warne Museum and Library, the locals began to call this bridge the "Old Bridge".

The old bridge became a key factor in the naming of this area along the South River. Originally called South Amboy, a percentage of the settlers divided and formed their own township from 1869-1975. They named it Madison Township, after President Madison who visited the area in the early 1800s. But soon there was much confusion between Madison Township and Madison, NJ of Morris County. So, in 1975 a new name was selected through a contest amongst the local residents to find the most popular name of choice. Since the old bridge that connected their town to East Brunswick had always been there as far as they could remember, it just seemed natural to reference this bridge when choosing a name for their town. Old Bridge Township became the approved name for this established waterfront New Jersey town on November 5, 1975.

THE TALENT OF ANGEL ORENSANZ

Angel Orensanz is a sculptor/painter born in Spain, who has lived in New York City since 1986. During one of his first art premieres in NYC he discovered a location that could best be described as long time abandoned and totally rundown. Despite the flourishing internationally active cultural center that it is today, the location he encountered was the Lower East Side.

Upon his arrival he disregarded the decayed appearance and focused his attention full swing onto the 1849 Neo-Gothic Jewish Synagogue located on 172 Norfolk Street, the heart of the Lower East Side. This building is a replica of the Sistine Chapel in Rome and the very temple of Solomon. In 1978, Angel Orensanz renovated this elaborate landmark and created his own foundation that today still carries his name.
